Western States Championships Eligibility: To be eligible for the Western States Championship, a participant must: 1) be a member of a western club (Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Washington, Wyoming); 2) have lived in the western states for six of the previous 12 months; and 3) be eligible for a USOF championship.

WRE: All M21+ / F21+ entrants automatically qualify for WRE entry. Please provide your WRE number on the registration form if you have one.

Relay Teams: Composition of relay teams and relay bib distribution will occur on Wednesday after Sprint event or early Thursday.

US Championships Eligibility: You are eligible to vie for US Individual Championship if you are a USOF member in good standing and meet one of the following citizenship requirements: 1) Are U.S. citizens and citizens of no other country; 2) Are in a permanent residence status commonly referred to as "green card carriers"; 3) Hold dual (U.S.) citizenship and reside primarily in the United States; 4) Hold dual (U.S.) citizenship, reside primarily outside the United States, and have not yet and agree not to compete for a championship title in another country during the current calendar year; or 5) Are full-time students in the U.S. holding a current student visa.

Junior: Competitors 18 years of age and under qualify for *Junior* fee structure.

Recreation: Recreation course option is available only on White, Yellow and Orange courses. No advanced registration required. No USOF/COF/IOF discounts.
